

One of the objectives of the York Region Athletic Association is "to provide opportunities for, and development of, the individual teacher-coach." To that end, the YRAA has established a Teacher-coach Development Fund with all the monies collected by the YRAA from fines, infractions (eg. missed preseason meetings, board of reference fees). This fund will be used to help offset the cost of coaching courses taken by active teacher-coaches or teachers that are intending to become YRAA coaches within one year. By helping to offset the costs of professional development for teacher-coaches, it is hoped that more teachers will seek out development opportunities in order to enhance the sport experience we provide for our students.

Below are the criteria that must be met in order to qualify to be reimbursed:

- The sport covered by the course must be a YRAA sanctioned sport.
- The applicant must be a teacher in good standing with the YRAA.
- The applicant must be an active teacher-coach at a YRAA member school or have committed to coach a team within one school year.
- The applicant must pay the course costs up-front and submit the original receipt with the completed application form to be reimbursed. Submissions must be made within one year of taking the course.
- The applicant must identify additional funding received for attendance at the course (eg. funding received from OSSTF or OECTA, school principal etc.)
- 50% of the cost of the course (excluding food, transportation costs etc.) to a maximum of \$100 per course may be covered.
- Teacher-coach Development funds are available on a first come first served basis and will be distributed until the fund is exhausted.
