3. Eligibility

Enrolled in no more than their fifth consecutive year from the initial date of entry to secondary school and born no more than 19 years prior to the start of the school year in which the competition is held.

School/Team Registration and Eligibility Deadline: Tuesday, September 17, 2019 by 5:00 p.m. to Martin Gorman at martin.gorman@yrdsb.ca

Does not have golf designated as their primary sport if attending a sport school or sport academy.

Important Note: Schools are allowed to register five (5) athletes but only four (4) are eligible to play in the tournament with one (1) being the alternate.

4. Transfer Eligibility

Any student/athletes who have transferred to a school in the previous 12 months is ineligible to participate in the YRAA interschool events or OFSAA sanctioned tournaments until he/she is deemed eligible by the YRAA Transfer Eligibility Committee.

Transfer Meetings will be held on Thursdays - please check with the YRAA. Thursday, September 12th and Thursday, September 19th at 1:00 pm. These are the only two dates before the tournament; check with your athletes.

5. Playing Regulations

Playing Regulations available at www.yraa.com Teams:

Teams consists of maximum of 5 players

Any four (4) may play in the qualifying round. Teams/golfers must compete in a qualifier in order to compete in the championship.

Three (3) scores count for team championship.

Teams of less than three (3) are eligible for individual title only. Individual scores count towards individual low gross championship. To qualify for the Championship Round, golfers must compete in or be an alternate in the Qualifier Round in order to compete in the Championship

Round.

Tie-Breaking Procedure - see Playing Regulations

Coaches should note there have been important changes to Player Designations this year.

A student-athlete who has competed in a provincial or national tournament within the past 12 months outside of the high school program, shall be classified as an Open participant within the individual division.

With the above in mind: All schools will play in a qualifier, on the same day, to determine the 15 qualifying teams and open individuals for both the junior and senior boys Championship competitions. To be eligible for the Championship round as an individual or as part of a team, a player must have scored at least 99 or better for Senior or 105 or better for a Junior. Once the top 15 or fewer teams have been identified and number of entries determined from the teams, the remaining spots (to a maximum of 68 players in the field) will be given to the top scoring individuals, who meet the scoring criteria, remaining from the qualifying round. The individual spots will be allocated in the following order:

1st Open Individual, 1st High School Individual, 2nd Open Individual, 2nd High school Individual ...

6. Practice Round /Tournament Dates

Practice Round: Monday, September 16th using both courses * for tee times scheduled between 8:00 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Players cost is \$40.00 tax in. Convenor negotiated that Coaches can play free within a group of 4 max. with 3 student players. It is the Coach's responsibility to book the tee times designating number of players and coaches participating in each group (max. 4) ASAP and by Friday September 14th at the latest to Professional Shayne Dysart at shayne@springlakesgolf.com and cc (the Convenor) martin.gorman@yrdsb.ca. This email should include all names of players and coaches and which course you want to play on. (Seniors on EAST / Juniors on NORTH) *

This is a practice round for team players and alternates only. This should not be used for Team Tryouts.
