Tournament Format:

1.0 The Buy-Out Game will begin with this opening prayer followed by the Canadian National Anthem sung by a student / students from the school (St. BA CHS) specifically and the audience in general. <u>Team Prayer</u> which is read prior to every game:

We thank you, Oh Lord, for the people who enrich our lives:

for those who are always willing to be a sounding board,

for teammates who accept us for what we are,

for competitors who bring out the best in us and

for those who set an example worthy of followed. Amen.

Every game in the tournament will involve four full eight minute quarters, stop time and a one minute break between the First & Second Quarters and the Third & Fourth Quarters.

Half time will be a five minute break which will allow both teams to retreat to their respective changing rooms. In the first game for each team one player will be selected by the team coach to participate in a one minute three point shot shoot-out with one point for each basket and two points for the last basket in each of the three sets of five basketballs. The player with the highest score would be asked to attend the awards ceremony following the Gold Medal Game on Saturday afternoon. If there is a tie these players would be asked to compete prior to the Gold Medal game in a three free throw shootout final.

Each registers team will be guaranteed THREE games. (Three games are guaranteed) This is unlikely, but

- If there is a tie in the Ranking for Saturday Games the tie will be broken by the overall +/- record obtained so far
- If teams are tied based on +/- then the tie breaker will be Points Against This will prevent teams from RUNNING UP scores.
- There will be a CAP of 15 points to also discourage RUNNING UP scores .
- Coin Toss will brake a continued tie.
